Witnessed and were given a <i>Pulmonaria officinalis</i> young seedling 9cm pot for pollinators	Outside in part shade, pot on next spring but keep me posted on fb workshop page
Filling pots and cells; compost, nutrients, soil	N/A
Watering effectively	N/A
Sowed lettuce seeds into a 1 litre pot, 2 types (fast rollers and white ovals)	Inside Sunny windowsill in a tray, white or foil back drop
Potted on a <i>Claytonia salad</i> small plug/cell into 9cm pot	Outside sunny spot in tray, watch them green up, these will need to be potted on again
Potted on <i>Freckles salad</i> 1 x small plug/cell into 9cm pot	Outside sunny spot in tray, watch them green up, these will need to be potted on again
Pricked out and potted on Italian giant parsley seedling into 4 x small plug/cells	Inside Sunny windowsill in a tray, white or foil back drop
Dug up a large perennial <i>Geranium nodosum</i> from propagation soil bed and potted on into soil 9cm pot	Outside in part shade, pot on next spring but keep me posted on fb workshop page
Pricked out and potted on 3 <i>Physalis edulis</i> seedlings, all into 9cm pot	Outside sunny spot in tray, watch them green up, these will need to be potted on again
